We ask Australian governments to:

- 01** Mandate climate education and sustainability across all levels of the **Australian national curriculum**.

- 02** Employ a **dedicated sustainability educator/co-ordinator** in every Australian school.

- 03** Support “ready to go” **climate education resources** so teachers can deliver quality, evidence-based climate education.

- 04** Mandate staff **professional learning and initial teacher education** on climate education, including school leaders, managers of corporate services and School Boards.

- 05** Prioritise **Green Skills in vocational courses & workplace learning** to help prepare young people for a net-zero emissions future.

- 06** Support a **connected community of educators** who share resources and practical ideas for climate education.

- 07** Support **transformative education** to deliver quality climate change education through action- and project-based learning that **connect young people with Country** and supports their **health and well-being**.

- 08** Ensure that all entities work in partnership with schools, VET and careers in pursuit of **Australia’s bipartisan support for the Paris Agreement, UN Sustainable Development Goals** and recommendations of the report on the **WA Parliamentary Inquiry into the Response of WA Schools to Climate Change (2022)**.

- 09** Require all educational institutions to demonstrate sustainability in their **management of materials and resources**.

- 10** Demonstrate climate change action in all **school governance, planning and operational documents and policies**, in line with the Paris Agreement and Australia’s Net Zero Pathway to 2050.
